



## Change to US grade levels

**Elementary School:** Kindergarten (5-6 years old) through 5th grade (10-11 years old)

**Middle School:** 6th (11-12 years old) through 8th grade (13-14 years old)

**High School:** 9th (13-14 years old) through 12th grade (17-18 years old)

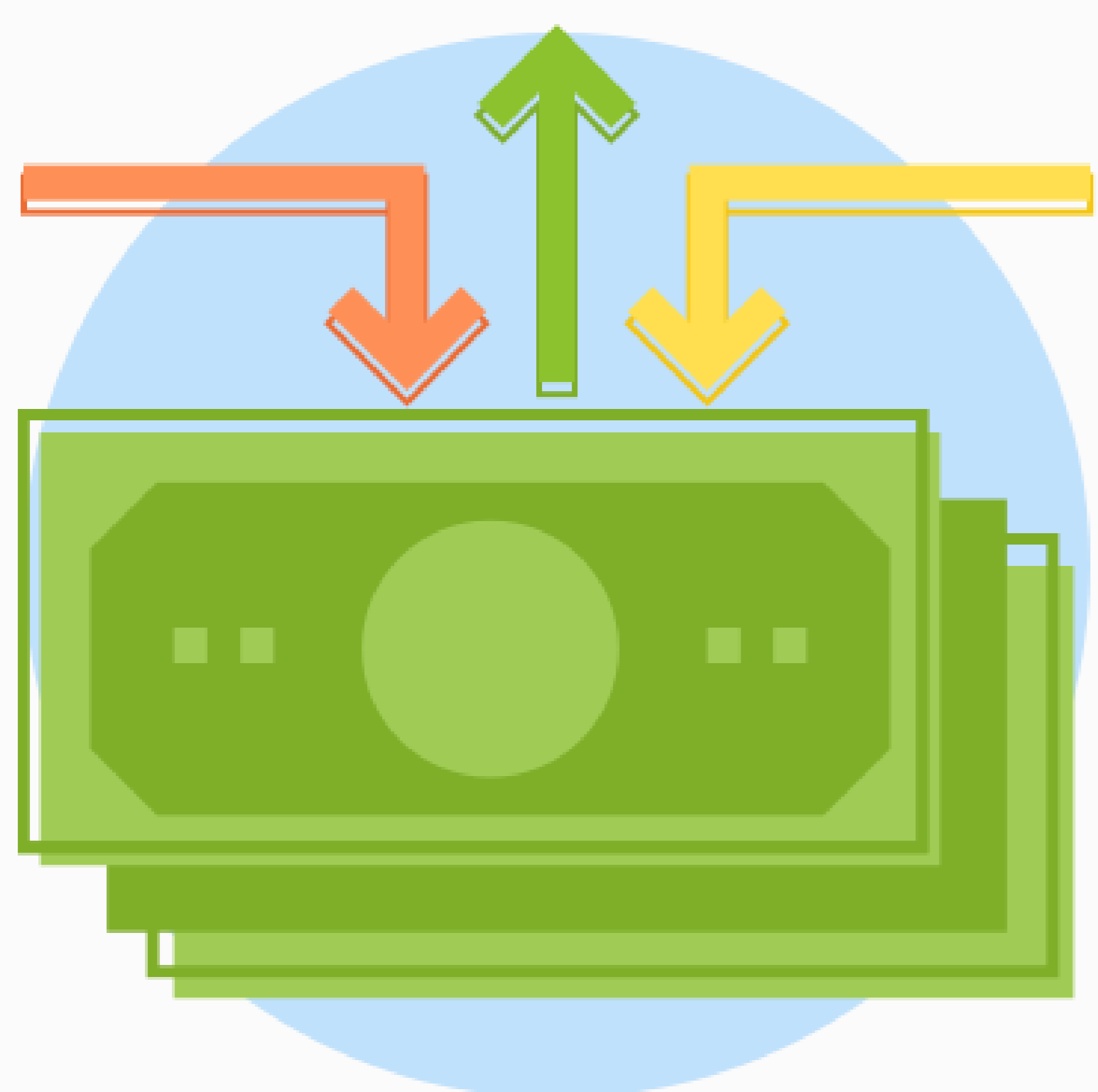
